



Leaf Prints

Introduction: We are going to get some shade from the leaves, as today we will be using sunlight to print leaves onto paper.

Approximate Time: 2 hours (mostly waiting)

Materials:

- Construction paper (any color)
- A piece of glass or clear plastic (ex. picture frame)
- Leaves or other flat objects you want to print onto the paper



Procedure:

1. Gather the leaves you would like to print onto the paper.
2. Arrange the leaves on the paper as you would like.
3. Once they are in place, get the piece of glass or clear plastic and put it on top of the paper. If you have a picture frame, you can cut the paper to fit in the frame and put it inside.
4. Let this setup sit out in a constantly sunny spot for about 2 hours.
5. Once it has sat out for long enough, take the setup and remove the glass and leaves. There should now be prints where the leaves were on the paper.

Tips & Tricks:

- If the leaf prints are dull, you can leave it out for longer.
